



Top 10 MUSTS at ArtWalk on the Bay 2008

1) Preview!

Visit www.artwalkonthebay.org and preview the artists before you come. This will help you find the pieces you love, and it will also help you to re-connect with the artists long after the event.

2) Navigate!

There is so much to see at ArtWalk on the Bay, so be sure to navigate through the entire event. The meandering pathway throughout the park leads you to amazing artistic discoveries.
